

SPEAK UP AND LET'S DO SOMETHING ABOUT IT!

GUIDANCE TO WHISTLEBLOWERS

A whistleblower is someone who reports waste, fraud, abuse, corruption, or dangers to public health and safety to someone who is in the position to rectify the wrongdoing.

Right to choose to remain anonymous

Do not disclose using company equipment or networks

Disclosures must be treated as confidential

When should you report?

If you are aware of any incidents or have suspicions concerning any violation of applicable laws/regulations or any breach of the Code of Conduct or other misconduct report it immediately.

What should you report?

- Bribery and corruption
- Excessive gifts and hospitality
- Facilitation payments
- Money laundering
- Non-disclosed conflicts of interests
- Fraud
- Any form of harassment or discrimination
- Financial irregularities
- Breaches of data privacy regulations

When reporting, please provide as much detail as you can to assist investigations.
